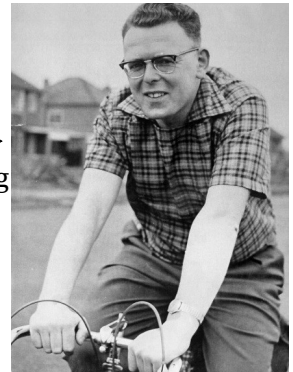

2 ROLL OF HONOUR



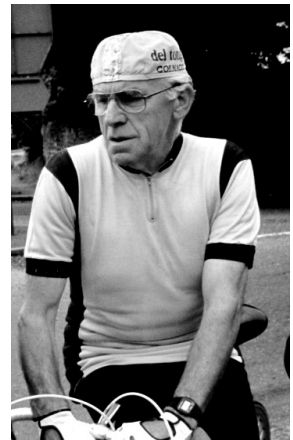
◀ **GEORGE ARSTALL** was Seamons' first club President in 1958-60, and again in 1965-68. A leading local racing man at all distances from Hill Climbs to 24 hours, George was club champion on multiple occasions.

DENNIS CHAPMAN served on Seamons' committee over many years in many roles, including Secretary and President 1963-4 and again in 1975. Dennis Chapman was also one of the many exceptional photographers in the club's history. ▶



◀ **BOB HILL** 'The Major', was a Founding Member, who served on Seamons' committee in various capacities, including Secretary and President 1961-62. Bob Hill specialised in grass track racing, but also rode the 24 hour and was in the winning Seamons team.

GEOFF HORROCKS served on the committee in various roles, including many years as Treasurer, and organised many open time trials in Seamons' name. ▶



◀ **MALC JUDGE** was a leading long distance rider who brought considerable honour to the club. Winner of the Manchester BAR and the Mersey Road Club's 24 hour, as well as Club Champion and BAR on numerous occasions. Malc also served as club President 1969-70.

NOEL MILLS served on the committee in various positions, including many years as club Chairman. Noel promoted a number of open events and organised the club dinner for many years. ▶



◀ **BOB RICHARDSON** was a founder member, joining in Feb 1949 as member No. 3. Riding bamboo rims, Bob won the club's first semi-open event in 1950, the Bolton Clarion 25. A former Chairman, President and Life Member, Bob cared passionately about the club and touring.

KEITH WILKINSON Wilkie was a former club vice-president, twice winner of the most meritorious award and a committed clubman. For many years he was the backbone of the touring section both as runs leader and touring secretary. ▶



◀ **JIM BOYDELL** joined the club in the late 1950's, initially as a tourist but started racing in 1960 when he won the Manchester Area Wagstaff Award as best first year rider. He held every club record from 10 miles to 12 hours. His best ride was in winning the local 12 hour race in 1965 with a distance of 263 miles. He held many club offices included those of Chairman and President. He organised both open and National time-trial events and was a fantastic clubman.

WELCOME TO SEAMONS



SEAMONS CYCLING CLUB was formed in 1948 as an offshoot of the Seamons Moss community centre in the Oldfield Brow area of Altrincham. The club quickly became a success and has grown steadily over the years to what it has become today; one of the biggest and most active cycling clubs in the North West. In 2008 we celebrated our Diamond Jubilee with a record membership and we're still growing.

We are proud of the fact that we are a 'proper' cycling club that caters for *all* cyclists whether your interest lies in Touring, Mountain Biking, Time Trialling, Road Racing or Track. In fact most of our members have a go at most, if not all, of these activities.

Locally we play an active part in the Trafford Cycling Forum to influence those decisions of interest to cyclists closer to home.

So far our success in racing has produced an Olympic pursuit rider, a British Best All- Rounder, a Commonwealth Games Silver Medallist plus three others who have finished in the top twelve of that competition. On three wheels we have seen two riders take the National BAR title, one of them also a Road Records Association, and Northern RRA Tricycle, tandem tricycle record holder and World Champions. In our Jubilee year we took all the major honours in the Manchester & District Time Trial Association with Seamons riders finishing in the top three places. Over the years we have been honoured to promote National Championships on three occasions for Cycling Time Trials.

Our club has a distinguished history, so when you wear Seamons CC colours we hope that it is with pride, and that you continue our proud traditions.

4 SEAMONS HISTORY

This article was first published in the Squirrel in April 1956. This abridgement was published in the August 1963 edition and re-published in Spring 2010.



The club was formed late in 1948, but the idea began some time previously. Bob Hill and Bob Richardson had been friends and keen cyclists for some time, when, in 1944, the army put a stop to Bob Hill's capers. By the time that he was demobbed there was a



small band of enthusiasts meeting outside the Richardson residence early each Sunday morning.

Members of that group were Bob Richardson, Bob Hill, Frank Acton, Pete Baguley, 'Mad' Walton, and Ken Glarvey. Then others joined them; Jack Food (two weeks in bed after his first ride), Ray Holmes, Reg Blease and Roy Davenport.

During this period the two Bobs became members of the newly formed Seamons Moss Community Centre, where they met up with Alan Spence and Geoff Robinson of Altrincham Ravens. So following discussions on cycling, the idea of a cycling club within the Centre was born. Geoff Robinson made the initial move by calling a meeting of those interested in October 1948. Alan Spence was elected chairman, and Bob Hill became first secretary.

The Club grew from strength to strength but also had conflicting opinions and ideas with the management committee of the Centre. The trouble came to a head twelve months later, and consequently the Club left the Centre as a body, and the Toc H Club Room became our temporary HQ.

It was at this time that all prize money, won during the season by the lads, was returned to the Club funds, and with a subscription from all members the "25" mile TT Trophy came into being. Ray Holmes was the first winner.

From the Toc H we moved to the Parish Rooms behind St Margaret's Church, where we stayed for some considerable time until the move in 1955 to the Civil Defence HQ. Of that group of founder members and first year members the only ones remaining in the Club are Bob Richardson, Bob Hill and "Irves" Irving. Also George Arstall and our president Dennis Chapman.

The remainder have either lost their enthusiasm or are now married and dare not come out on Sunday. Geoff Robinson is now settled in Canada, although he has been over twice. (He gave us an interesting movie show in May).



- The club welcomes everyone and will respect and treat them equally.
 - Members will ride with consideration for other members... Treat other members with the respect they would themselves expect...
 - Members observe and respect the Highway Code, treating other road users with the respect they themselves expect.
 - When you are wearing the club kit at any time you are representing the club and are responsible for its reputation.
 - The club can only exist and be successful through the commitment of its members. All members are expected to actively contribute to club life.
 - Seamons Cycling Club is not run to make a profit. Surplus funds will be allocated for the benefit of current and future members, or the development of cycling in general.
 - The club is managed by an elected committee that is accountable to members at all times. Members will elect their committee at the annual general meeting.
 - Committee members and others give their time willingly in relation to club activities. Apart from occasional agreed and necessary expenses, there will be no financial remuneration for any activity undertaken.
 - Members are expected to volunteer their services to at least one event on the Club Calendar. We now have over 200 members and would like to emphasise that, given the relatively low cost of club membership when compared with other sporting organisations, and the time spent by many members on providing activities from which all benefit, then every member volunteering support for at least one club activity per year is a reasonable expectation.

Constitution

- 1 This Club shall be called the "Seamons Cycling Club".
 - 2 The Club colours shall be Royal Blue, White and Yellow, and the Club emblem shall be a squirrel.
 - 3 The purpose of the club is to provide facilities for, and to promote the amateur sport of cycling, in the North Cheshire / South Manchester area, together with community participation in the same.
 - 4 AGM Date & Purpose: The Annual General Meeting will take place in November (by convention the evening of the 2nd Friday) to receive the reports of the club's officers and the audited Statement of Accounts, to elect club officials, and to transact any other business required.
 - 5 Notice of an AGM: The Secretary shall forward notice of the Annual General Meeting to individual members by e-mail at least 6 weeks prior to the meeting. The notice shall include the date, time and place of the meeting, and will invite the submission of items for inclusion in the agenda. Agenda items should be received by the Secretary, in writing, not less than 28 days prior to the meeting.
 - 6 Agenda for an AGM / EGM: The Secretary shall forward a copy of the final version of the agenda for any General Meeting to all individual members by e-mail at least 14 days prior to the meeting, unless requested to provide a paper copy. The agenda will include the date, time and place of the meeting, the purpose of the meeting and the full wording of all propositions for consideration by the General Meeting. Where multiple members of a family live at the same address, a single paper copy will be sent to that address.
 - 7 Any alterations to this Constitution or any other matter affecting the general policy of the Club must be sanctioned by a two-thirds majority at an AGM or EGM.
 - 8 The Club shall be governed by a committee elected by the members at the club's Annual General Meeting. Elections may be held at an Extra-ordinary General Meeting if required.
 - 9 The committee shall meet as often as business demands.
 - 10 The club elects biennially at the AGM a president and vice-president both of whom must be current members. The elections for each post to take place in alternate years, holders will not be eligible to serve consecutive terms. Nominees for President should be consulted prior to the AGM. Nominations for President should be in writing and seconded before the date of the AGM.
 - 11 Club members only shall be eligible for election as Club Officials.
 - 12 An Extraordinary General Meeting may be called at any time by a simple majority of the committee, or by any member providing he/she has the written support of not less than twenty members of the Club.
 - 13 Any matter not provided for in the Constitution, shall be dealt with by the committee, whose decision shall be binding on all parties.
 - 14 Disputes arising in the Club are to be addressed to the General Secretary and approved by the committee.
 - 15 The financial year shall run from 1st October to 30th September.

8 CLUB RULES

Constitution

- 16 The Club funds shall be under the control of the committee and, if required, be banked in the name of the Club. Withdrawals made as required on the joint signatures of the Treasurer and authorized signatories.
- 17 The members may vote to wind up the Club, if not less than three quarters of those present and voting support that proposal, at a properly convened General meeting. The Committee will then be responsible for the orderly winding up of the Club's affairs. After settling all liabilities of the Club, the Committee shall donate the remaining net assets either to another amateur cycling club, or to one of the sports national governing bodies such as CTC or BC.
- 18 (a) The property and funds of the Club cannot be used for the direct or indirect private benefit of the members, other than as reasonably allowed by the Committee.
(b) The Club may indemnify the Committee and Members, acting properly in the course of running the Club, against any liability incurred in the running of the Club, but only to the extent of its assets.
- 19 (a) Membership shall be open to anyone regardless of gender, disability, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, religion or other beliefs, from the age of 13. Members' children under the age of 13 may join the club, provided they are accompanied by a parent or guardian on club activities.
(b) 'Go Ride' membership shall be open to children of 5 years or older and under 13 years of age. 'Go Ride' members can participate in club activities that take place in traffic-free environments. A 'Go Ride' member will not need to be related to a full member and will not have voting rights at AGMs or EGMs, nor are they eligible to stand for the club's committee.
- 20 All prospective members must be proposed & seconded by current members of the club, and accepted by the committee.
- 21 Membership shall run from the 1st January to the 31st December. Any member, one month or more in arrears with their subscription shall be deemed to have resigned.
- 22 Members who ride on the public highway must, at all times, also be members of BC (Ride, Silver or Gold), Cycling UK, The LVRC, TLI Cycling or British Triathlon (Ultimate or Core membership).
- Please Note - when accessing any insurance, members are strongly recommended to read carefully and understand which aspects of cycling are, or are not, included. All five insurance providers named above meet the basic requirements to ride with the Club. The Cyclist Touring Club, or CTC as they were formally known, is now "Cycling UK". You must have current Third Party Insurance from one of the above to ride with SCC.
- 23 All members of Seamons Cycling Club are required to abide by the British Cycling Child Protection Policy when engaged in activities that involve children. Advice on compliance with this policy will be provided by the club's Child Welfare Officer.
- 24 (a) The committee may refuse membership, or remove it, only for good cause such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute.
(b) An appeal against refusal or removal may be made to the members.
- 25 Any member may nominate another for life membership of the club but the final decision will be made by existing life members.

Constitution

- 26 The Roll of Honour stands to record those members of the club, now deceased, who served the club loyally over a period of time. The nominee must still have been a member at the time of his/her death. Nominations for inclusion in the Roll of Honour can be made by any member of the club, with the final decision resting with the Life Members and Committee.

Explanatory notes

- 1 A cyclist may be a member of more than one club, but can be a first claim member of only one. The rider may only compete in road races or time trials under the name of their first claim club. All other memberships are second claim.
 - 2 New members joining after 30th June will only be required to pay one half of the annual membership fee for that year.
 - 3 Where a new member joins late in the year, the Membership Secretary has the discretion to waive the annual membership fee for that year.
 - 4 When a member first joins, or re-joins after membership lapsing (Art. 21), a joining fee of £5 is payable.

Miscellaneous rules

- 1 Go Ride events: A qualified British Cycling Go Ride coach must be present for the duration of any Seamons' Go Ride event.
 - 2 E-Bikes: any E bike used by a club member must be fully compliant with the legal requirements in force at the time in the UK E-Bikes are not permitted in any competitive events.

10 CLUB RULES

Racing rules

- 1 The Club Championship trophies shall be competed for annually.
- 2 First Claim members only are eligible for Club Championship awards
- 3 All qualifying events will be chosen by the committee and published prior to the start of the season.
- 4 The **CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP** for the **D K HARTLEY** trophy shall be competed for annually over distances of 25, 50 and 100 miles. The best time at each distance to count in the nominated events.
- 5 The **CLUB BEST ALL-ROUNDER** competition for the **GEORGE ARSTALL** trophy shall be competed for over distances of 50, 100 miles and 12 hours, the best average speed to count. All Open events are eligible.
- 6 Both the club's **SENIOR ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIP** & the club's **JUNIOR ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIP** (for the **FRED MINSHULL** trophy) are to be competed for on a points system. The member who achieves the highest aggregate points score will be the club champion.

Points will be allocated to members for actual places in any number of BC or TLI Cycling promoted road or circuit races during the road race season, e.g. 6 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 6th place.

The club's **VETERAN ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIP** shall be competed for by veteran riders, aged 40+, in any number of BC, LVRC and TLI Cycling promoted road or circuit races during the road race season. The riders' best ability category placings in BC events, and/or age-category placings in TLI or LVRC events, to be counted.

Points will be awarded for the top six placings within an ability category (BC), or age-category (TLI or LVRC), in any such event. (Six points for 1st place down to one point for 6th place).

The veteran with the highest aggregate points score will be the champion.

Female veteran members will normally compete in the age-category (TLI & LVRC) appropriate to a male competitor 10 years older.

(For all road race championships, where a rider has taken part in a Stage race, then he/she is entitled to count the accumulated points from individual stages (not including time trial stages) or points for the General Classification position. Whichever is the greater, but not both).

The **YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP for the ROY VERNON** trophy will be awarded to the youth member who achieves the highest aggregate points score using a system based on 3 time trials and 3 road (or closed circuit) races.

The Youth Champion is the member who attains the highest number of points for actual places in up to 3 (10 mile) club time trials and up to 3 road or circuit races. Time Trial points will be those allocated on the Club 10 Points Table website page and, for Road or Circuit races, 24 pts for a1st, 22 for 2nd, 20 for 3rd, 18 for 4th, 16 for 5th and 14 for 6th, in any BC or TLI Cycling road or circuit races.

- 7 The **JUNIOR TT CHAMPIONSHIP** trophy shall be competed for over three 10-mile & three 25-mile events, to be nominated by the committee. The best time at each distance to count towards the average speed.
-

- 8 The **JUNIOR BAR for the REG BLEASE TROPHY** shall be competed for over 10 & 25 miles. The fastest average speed at each of these distances to count. All national and club events are eligible.
 - 9 The **R RICHARDSON HANDICAP** trophy shall be awarded to the rider completing the fastest time on Handicap in the Club Championship 25 mile time trial.
 - 10 The Club **VETERANS BAR CHAMPIONSHIP** to be based on the National Veterans table of standard times.
 - 11 The Club **TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP** to be selected by the committee.
 - 12 The Club **CYCLO-CROSS CHAMPIONSHIP** to be selected by the committee.
 - 13 The **VETERANS CHAMPIONSHIP** to be competed for over the same 25, 50 and 100 mile events selected for the D K HARTLEY trophy, the winner being determined using the standards laid down by the VTTA.
 - 14 The **RW CHAPMAN** trophy shall be competed for over a series of 10 mile time-trials on courses decided by the committee. The trophy will be presented to the rider with the highest number of points gained over any 12 events during the season. Points will be allocated on a basis of 30 to the winner, decreasing to 1 point for 30th place in each event. All club & Inter Club events to qualify. The "**First Year Rider Award**" shall be competed for as detailed above, the winner receiving a plaque to keep. The **DARREN BUCKLEY TROPHY** shall be competed for as above and shall be awarded to the best first year Youth rider. A first year rider is a rider who has ridden no more than 3 open or club events in previous seasons.
 - 15 The **BEV CHAPMAN** trophy will be awarded to the Junior who records the fastest time at 25 miles in any event and on any course during the season.
 - 16 Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd women in all championships with a plaque to the Women's Champion in the 10 & 25 mile events.
 - 17 The **WOMEN'S BAR CHAMPIONSHIP** shall be competed for annually over distances of 25, 50 & 100 miles, the best times at each distance to count. All Open events & Club 25 are eligible.
 - 18 The **WOMEN'S TIME TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIP** for the **KEITH STACEY TROPHY** shall be competed for annually over distances of 10, 25 & 50 miles. The best time at each distance to count from the nominated events.
 - 19 For the purpose of these rules, the age category definitions for SCC competitions will be: Youth for U16, Junior for 16-17. Youth and Junior riders move up a category at the year-end, following their 15th and 17th birthdays respectively.
 - 20 The Official Club racing jersey is predominantly Royal Blue, White & Yellow. Only the latest design is registered with British Cycling and **must** be worn in all BC events.
 - 21 All competitors in evening club events must use a working LED rear light.
 - 22 **PLACE-TO-PLACE RECORDS:** An attempt may be made at any time subject to the previous approval of the timekeepers marshals by the TT Secretary. A place-to-place shall be between Altrincham main post office and the main post office at the far end (but refer to individual records for revised rules). Claims are made in writing, signed by the claimant and the official concerned. From 2000 onwards both Chester & Middlewich records can be attacked from revised starting points. See the TT Secretary for details and to arrange an attempt.

12 CLUB RULES

- 23 **CLUB RACING STANDARDS:** A rider can claim a standard at a particular level **ONCE**. Once awarded at that level you must improve to the next level for a further award. All claims must be made in writing to the Time Trial Secretary. (see below).

All successful claimants will receive a certificate. You may also optionally request a medal to be paid for at cost price.

- 24 **RELIABILITY & ROUGH STUFF RIDES:** All cycles must be complete and sound for the conditions likely to be encountered. A certificate is awarded to those completing one, two or three such rides. A medal is awarded to those who complete three such rides.

Non-racing awards

- 1 **MALC JUDGE LONG DISTANCE TROPHY:** In memory of Malc Judge, his widow Pam, has donated a trophy to be awarded each year to the person who, in the opinion of the committee, has produced the most meritorious long distance ride or rides. This may be a touring challenge, an audax (or series of audax rides) or racing performance.
 - 2 **'LIL WINDSOR CUP' TOURIST TROPHY:** The trophy shall be awarded to the member who has gained most points in designated touring events during the year. The trophy is open to first claim members only.
 - 3 **REG HERBERT TROPHY:** The committee shall make this award to the most deserving lady member for either a significant personal achievement or service to the club.
 - 4 **BEST CLUBMAN TROPHY:** A year-long competition which aims to encourage participation in, and support for, the activities of the club.

Nigel Harrop 1950-2021

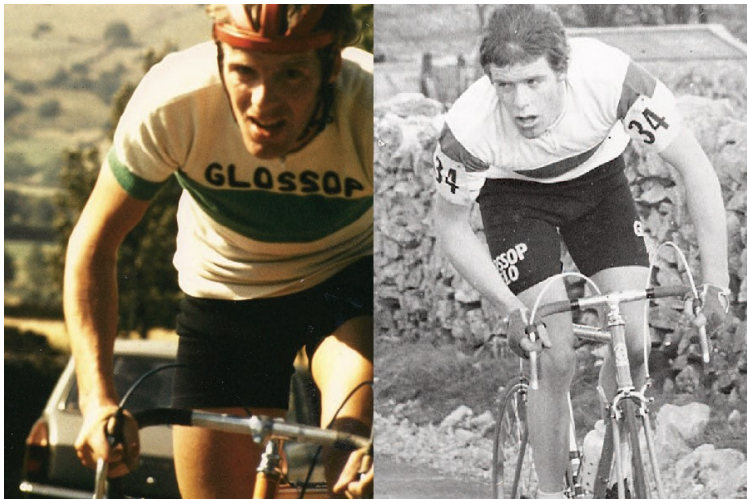
Nigel was suddenly and unexpectedly taken ill at home this February 2021 he was rushed to the hospital, but sadly died during surgery.

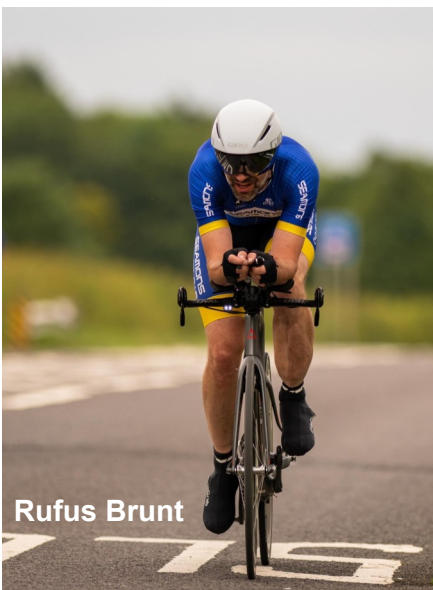
