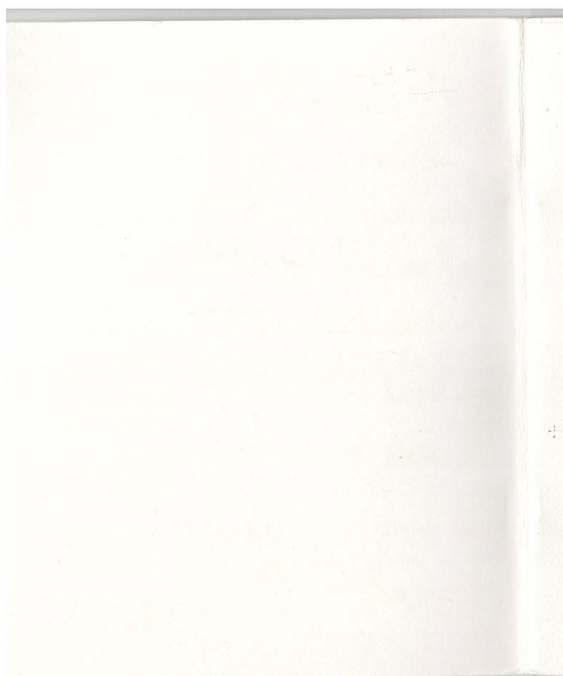

## RULES

1. THAT this Club shall be called "SEAMONS CYCLING CLUB".
2. THAT the Club shall be governed by a committee elected at an Annual General Meeting.
3. THAT the Committee shall meet as often as business shall demand.
4. THAT the financial year shall finish on the 31st December every year.
5. THAT all prospective members shall complete two Club runs before being considered for membership. They must be proposed and seconded by two other members and accepted by the committee.
6. THAT membership shall be open to both sexes from 13 years old.
7. SUBSCRIPTIONS:

For 1st CLAIM MEMBERSHIP:

Age 18 and over 10/- plus either 20/- B.C.F.  
or 25/- C.T.C.

Age 16-18, 6/- plus either 15/- B.C.F. or  
15/- C.T.C.

Age 13-16, 6/- plus either 10/- B.C.F. or 15/-  
C.T.C.

New B.C.F. members 1/- extra

FOR 2nd CLAIM MEMBERS:

Over 21 years 7/6d, 18 to 21 years, 5/-.

FOR SOCIAL (NON-CYCLING) MEMBERS: Over 17 yrs. 10/-

8. THAT any member two months in arrears with subscriptions shall pay 1/- in addition to the normal fee up to three months, when they shall be deemed to have resigned.
9. THAT the committee have power to expel any member whose conduct is adjudged to be injurious to the Club.
10. THAT disputes arising in the Club are to be addressed to the Hon. General Secretary and approved by the committee.
11. THAT 1st claim members only shall be eligible for election as Club officials.

12. THAT the Club colours shall be Royal Blue and Gold, and the Club emblem shall be a squirrel.
13. THAT members desirous of resigning shall notify the Hon. General Secretary before the 31st Dec. of that year.
14. THAT the Club funds shall be under the control of the Committee and if need arise be banked in the name of "Seamons Cycling Club". Money to be withdrawn as required on the joint signatures of the Hon. Treasurer and authorised deputy.
15. THAT in the event of the Club becoming insolvent or disbanded each member be liable for a share of any debts outstanding in the name of the Club. In the case of any monies being to the credit of the Club to be distributed amongst suitable charities.
16. THAT any matter not provided for in these Rules shall be dealt with by the committee whose decision shall be binding on all parties.
17. THAT the Club elect bi-annually a President at the A.G.M. who must be a current member.
18. Any alterations to these Rules and any other matter affecting the general policy of the Club must be sanctioned by a two-thirds majority at a General Meeting. -4-

19. THAT any member shall have the power to call an extra-ordinary General Meeting provided he has the written support of no less than two thirds of the Club membership.

#### RACING RULES

1. The Club Time Trial Trophies shall be competed for annually.
2. The JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY shall be competed for annually over distances of three 10-mile events and three 25-mile events, the best time at each distance to count. The date of the events to be chosen from the list of Club racing events as thought to be the most suitable by the Committee. Only performances completed before the competitor's 19th birthday will be counted for the championship.
3. An attempt on a Club Place-to-Place Record may be made at any time, subject to previous approval of the Timekeepers, and Turn Marshals by the Hon. J. I. Secretary. The Place-to-Place Record shall be between Altrincham G.P.O. and the G.P.O. of the far turn. Claims to records shall be made in writing, signed by the Claimant and the Officials concerned.
4. The "D.K. HARTLEY TROPHY" for the Club Championship shall be competed for annually over a

distance of 25, 50 and 100 miles. Three events at each distance will be named by the committee annually, the best times at each distance to count.

5. The Club Best All-Rounder Competition for the "George Arstall" Trophy shall be competed for annually, the best average speed over distances of 50 miles, 100 miles and 12 hours to count, all events in the National B.A.R. are eligible.
6. The Club Road Race Championship shall be run annually on a points system, points being allocated to riders depending on finishing positions and category of events. A rider must finish in at least three events to qualify.
7. THAT first claim members only be eligible for all club championships.
8. The Junior B.A.R. Trophy shall be competed for annually, over 10, 25 and 30 miles. The best average speed over these distances to count. All events in the national handbook and club "tens" being eligible.

RULES FOR BEST CLUBMAN COMPETITION

1. THAT 2 points be awarded for attendance at the published dinner place and 1 point for attendance at the published tea place, at the same time as the official club party.
2. THAT 1 point be awarded for official club duties other than club nights (i.e. Cycling Proficiency Teaching).
3. THAT 3 points be awarded for attendance on Club nights.
4. THAT 3 points be awarded to any member prevented from attending by official duties, or members on official Club Tours (Points to be claimed in 7 days).
5. THAT the records be kept from A.G.M. to A.G.M. by a Club member delegated by the Committee.

TOURING SECTION RULES

1. THE Leader(s) of the Touring Section Run shall be responsible for its members, and shall report any cases of misconduct to the Club Committee.
2. Membership of a Run shall be open to all Club Members, but participation in a Run shall mean automatic acceptance of these rules.
3. Attendance on a Run shall count for the Best Clubman Competition.
4. The route and final destination of a Run shall be at the absolute discretion of the Leader(s).
5. The speed of the Run shall be such as to cause no hardship on the slowest rider.

#### RELIABILITY AND ROUGHSTUFF RIDES

All cycles must be complete and sound for the conditions likely to be encountered.

#### R.S. COMPETITION (Three-part)

A certificate is awarded to all completing any section. A medal for all completing all three.

#### LONG DISTANCE R.S. COMPETITION

A medal is awarded to all completing the course.

#### RELIABILITY RIDES

A certificate is awarded to all successful entrants.

#### TOURISTS TROPHY

All members are eligible to compete and all events in the Touring Calendar will count. The winner will hold the Lil. Windsor Tourist Trophy for one year.
